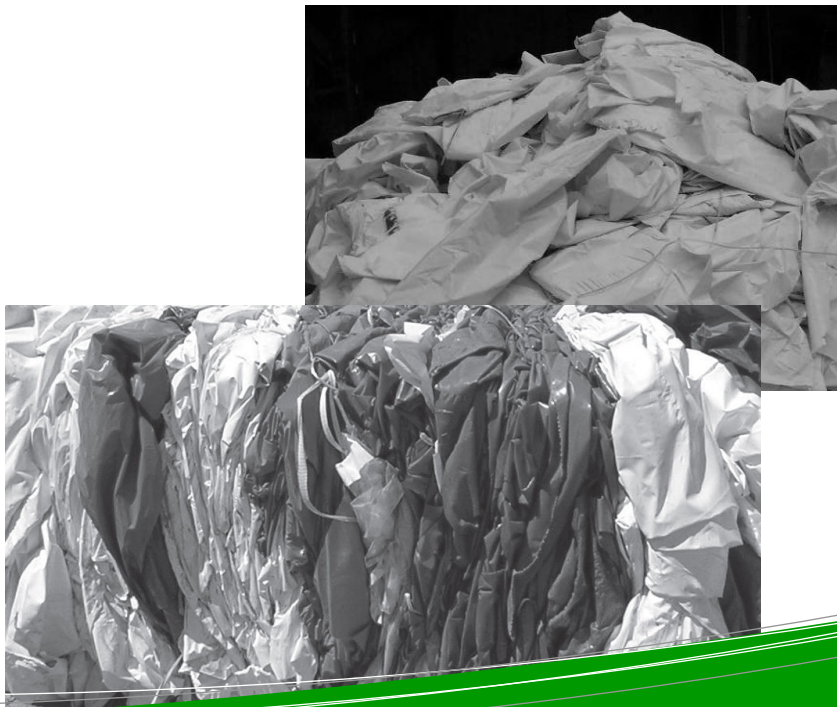


Since spring of 2006, Dynamic Waste Systems, Inc. has been offering marina operators and boaters an innovative and welcomed cost-effective alternative for recycling their boat shrink wrap. Through this effort, Dynamic Waste Systems, Inc. and participating local marinas have diverted over 100,000 lbs of boat shrink wrap from landfills each year. Once recycled, the materials may be used to manufacture new products including plastic bags, plastic lumber, guardrail blocks, wheel chocks, lawn edging, plastic banners, decking, and benches.



ABOUT SHRINK WRAP

Shrink wrap (Low-Density Polyethylene or LDPE) is commonly used for protecting recreational boats stored outside during the winter season from snow, ice, water and debris. The plastic encloses the vessel by heating and shrinking the plastic to make the plastic surfaces ridged thereby providing a protective covering strong enough to hold the weight of snow and ice. In the spring, used shrink wrap is often discarded and ends up in landfills.

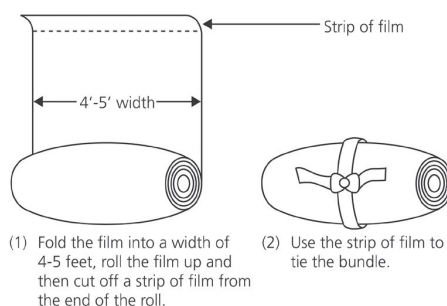
PREPARING YOUR SHRINK WRAP

1. Remove all lumber and other non shrink wrap materials (batteries, soda cans, screws, nails) from the shrink wrap. Any attached plastic ribbon strapping is acceptable.
2. Keep the shrink wrap as clean as possible. Gravel, sand, and excess dirt make the recycling process more difficult.
3. Maximize the amount of shrink wrap that will fit in your storage area and reduce water weight by rolling the shrink wrap into a bundle up to five feet long, similar to a rolled up sleeping bag. Tie the bundle with a strip of shrink wrap or ribbon strapping (see diagram) While rolling, keep the shrink wrap clean.
4. Place rolled shrink wrap in a designated storage area or in containers marked "SHRINK WRAP ONLY". Make sure to put only shrink wrap into the storage area or container. Contaminated and dirty shrink wrap may disrupt the recycling process decreasing the quality of the material.



PACKER TRUCK COLLECTION

1. Stockpile your prepared rolled shrink wrap in a designated storage area at your location.
2. Schedule the Dynamic Packer Truck for a one time , weekly, or bi-weekly pickup by calling Dynamic Dispatch Dept. at 1-866-654-8817.
3. "Live Load" your prepared rolled shrink wrap in the Dynamic Packer Truck on the scheduled pickup day.

ROLL-OFF CONTAINER COLLECTION

1. Call Dynamic Dispatch Dept. at 1-866-654-8817 to order delivery of a 30 Cu. Yd. Roll-Off Container for Boat Shrink Wrap Recycling.
2. Load your prepared rolled shrink wrap in the Dynamic Roll-Off Container until the container is level and full.
3. Call Dynamic Dispatch Dept at 1-866-654-8817 to order a swap or final removal.
